



Continue Funding our Education Programs

- Regional Safe Schools Programs (RSSP) are alternative education programs for disruptive students in grades 6-12 who have been administratively transferred from their district school.
- Currently, there are over 100 RSSP program sites in Illinois in urban, suburban and rural areas of the state.
- The RSSP has 48 grants representing 44 Regional Offices of Education (ROEs), three Intermediate Service Centers (ISCs) in Suburban Cook County and the Chicago Public Schools.

- Truants Alternative Optional Education Programs (TAOEP) focus on reducing truancy and include prevention and/or intervention services as well as optional education programs designed to prevent students from dropping out of school.
- There are over 55,000 students receiving TAOEP services statewide.
- Community Colleges, Regional Offices of Education, Local Education Agencies, and Vocational Centers are educational agencies receiving TAOEP funding.
